## Our mission statement

To fulfill this mission the program will support student academic achievement through quality tutoring and enhancing reading skills, provide interesting and engaging activities such as music, art and games; and teach life lessons such as responsibility, respect for others and teamwork.

### The Schedule includes:

Pick up from the schools at dismissal

A light snack

Homework and reading time

Volunteers are available to help with homework.

Parent Pick Up – all children must be picked up by 5:45 PM unless staying for our Angelic Voices.

### Some additional information

•Transportation from the Selinsgrove schools: Volunteer will escort the children from the elementary and intermediate schools – NOTE:

**We walk! (unless physical restrictions)**

•Any non-Selinsgrove student may come but parents must provide transportation. (times need to be established upon enrollment)

•Angelic Voices is a children’s choir of the Wesley United Methodist Church. All children are invited to join. The children sing approximately once a month at our services at Wesley UMC. They also provide the “core” for our children musicals and special programs. They rehearse from 5:45 – 6:45 pm
